Army hero is uni prof

ST Mary's University, Twickenham, has appointed Field Marshal Charles Guthrie as a visiting professor in its school of education, theology and leadership

Lord Guthrie has dedicated his professional life to the British Army, rising to Chief of the General Staff between 1994 and 1997 and Chief of Defence Staff between 1997 and 2001.

His military career involved service with the Welsh Guards and the Special Air Service; he was closely involved in military operations in Northern Ireland and provided advice to the British government during the Bosnian War and the Kosovo War.

Since 2013, he has been chancellor of Liverpool Hope University and is also a member of the House of Lords, sitting on the crossbenches for the last 14 years.

Lord Guthrie will have a particular focus on teaching leadership courses, including the Catholic school leadership and the leading innovation and change MAS, which offers school leaders valuable, career-building academic qualifications and skills to get ahead in the teaching profession.

He will also play a key role in the development of the school of education, theology and leadership, a nationally and internationally regarded provider of initial teacher education, theology and religious studies postgraduate programmes.

St Mary's vice-chancellor Francis Campbell said, "Lord Guthrie has a huge amount to offer our university with his incredible wisdom and expertise.

"In particular, our educational leadership masters students will gain the benefit of Lord Guthrie's experience at the top of complex organisations.

"His record of leading public institutions which aim to serve and protect key elements of society and the nation reflects our ambition here at St Mary's to espouse our values to the wider world.

"I look forward to welcoming Lord Guthrie when he takes up his position."

Lord Guthrie said, "It is a great honour to be involved with St Mary's. The university's school of education, theology and leadership has a first class reputation and I hope to make a valuable contribution working with the staff and students in their beautiful Strawberry Hill campus."
