The Dublin People group of newspapers has been serving Dublin communities since 1987 when the first edition of Northside People hit the streets. Today, the group publishes three popular weekly editions – Northside People (East), Northside People (West) and Southside People – along with a digital offering through its dublinpeople.com website and social media platforms. With a weekly print circulation of 120,000 across all three titles, the newspapers enjoy a Dublin readership of 340,000 (TGI, 2015). This breaks down as a readership of 182,000 for the two Northside People titles and 171,000 for Southside People. The firm says that 33.2 per cent of Dubliners read one of its titles every week.
