

# 40 UNDER 40 NOMINEES

Again this year the Sacramento Business Journal will recognize 40 business leaders younger than 40. Previous winners have included emerging entrepreneurs and executives in companies big and small across the four-county region.

This year's 40 Under 40 awards event and publication is scheduled for Dec. 14. Until then, the Business Journal will publish capsule profiles of selected nominees every other week, based on information they provided. Those profiled are chosen through a mathematically random process and have no greater chance of winning than any other nominee.

A panel of independent judges will choose the final 40 honorees based on their influence on local business and industry. Contributions to the civic health of the Sacramento region through volunteer work and other forms of philanthropy also will be considered.

Nominees must do business in Sacramento, El Dorado, Placer or Yolo counties. They must have been born after Dec. 14, 1972.
