





## My ordeal over 'flashing' slurs

A BUILDER falsely accused of being a sex offender spoke of his 'living nightmare' yesterday as his vindictive accusers were locked up.

Jason McCue was arrested and charged after 18-year-olds Lucie Rhimes and Ella Cooper claimed he had 'flashed' at them in the street.

The 34-year-old was facing up to two years in prison and suffered a mental breakdown as the lies left him feeling 'embarrassed and ashamed for something I've not even done'. His sevenmonth ordeal ended when Rhimes con-

fessed to her father that she and Cooper, of Preston, had made up the story.

They wanted to hurt McCue, also of Preston, following a dispute between him and Cooper's family. The victim said: 'These girls may have thought it was some kind of a joke but things got well and truly out of control.'

Cooper and Rhimes, of Chorley, admitted perverting the course of justice and were each sentenced to eight months jail by Preston crown court.
